In January 2021, without the possibility of doing our LLCC C1 training face-to-face with participants from the UK, Spain, Lithuania, Greece, Austria and Romania, we adapted it to an online training event. This always carries some technical difficulties, as well as the usual introversion this entails. However, we overcame these difficulties using many interactive methods, such as icebreakers, smaller discussion groups and, most important, online tools that facilitated participation in a fun an engaging way.

Partners introduced different interactive online tools to support the delivery of the pilot and engage participants, even in the case of a possible online delivery. Participants also went through the materials together to make sure they were useful for the trainers. The consortium successfully brought the trainer community together, welcoming feedback to improve the course modules and making sure that the next step, delivering the course to the target group will be effective.
